Spend **three evenings** in the 1920's with the New Bern Historical Society and all the spiffy flappers, sheiks, and swell characters who lived or visited New Bern. It will be the cat's pajamas!

Keep your eyes open for **18 Ghost Sites**. Ghosts and spirits will be spotted in buildings and homes throughout the historic downtown district. Don't be surprised when you encounter specters from New Bern's Roaring 20's, including Babe Ruth, Senator Furnifold Simmons, flappers and distillers of illegal bathtub gin. You may even see a ghost in a Tin Lizzie!

The Old Firehouse and the Firemen's Museum will be haunted during Ghostwalk. Ghostly firefighters will tell you about their explosive method of stopping the Great Fire!

New Bern Historic Masonic and Athens Theatres
