- ★ Open to all, children and adults. <u>Arrive at 11:30 for registration</u>.
- ★ Cost \$10 for first family member, \$5 for each additional, with \$20 max for family. No unaccompanied children. Reservations must be pre-paid so we can order food.
- ★ The event kicks off with a commissary lunch much like the soldiers would have eaten – Brunswick stew cooked over an open fire, hush puppies, and ham biscuits.
- ★ Children 6-12 will be "recruited" by the Civil War reenactors, be issued a cap and wooden rifle to keep, and elect to either drill with reenactors or do crafts and historic games.
- ★ Other visitors (adults, teens, younger children) are free to visit the other Civil Warera displays:
